Duties and Responsibilities

This is at entry level grade. An officer will normally be posted in a ward and will be required to work under supervision and guidance by senior and more experienced officers in undertaking the following duties:

- i) Meat inspection services;
- ii) Disease control activities such as disease search, vaccination and enforcement of livestock movement regulations including quarantines and management of livestock markets;
- iii) Participating in the training of stakeholders in vector control programmes;
- iv) Advising farmers on good veterinary practices;
- v) Collecting data and preparing reports on animal health, products and markets;
- vi) Providing advice on animal breeding and welfare;
- vii) Collecting samples for livestock disease diagnosis.
